

Guide to writing the sustainability actions of a project

Here are the questions you must answer to describe the sustainability of your project:

- what are the elements relating to the sustainability of the project, i.e. economic, social, environmental conditions, etc. which will allow the project to continue and the beneficiaries to benefit from it, once the funding is finished?

- what is the level of viability of the project? Explain which elements constitute a powerful lever justifying the relevance of the project (example: a dormitory built for young students to provide them with education in good conditions).

- what is the project continuity strategy? What makes the project continue after the funding stops? Recall the criteria and objectives that the project must achieve so that its viability is ensured and guaranteed once the funding is completed (example: solid training of beneficiaries, financial autonomy of the partner, etc.).
